# Notes from the Last Meeting

L. A. Cude gave us information on lacquer and sanding sealer and spraying of both. In his talk he mentioned the basic construction of lacquer and its relationship with nitrocellulose (the longer fibers of nitrocellulose being related to harder, more durable lacquer than the shorter fibers) and "hot" thinners that speed drying and serve to fuse the previous layers of lacquer into one coherent surface.

L. A. then went out to the loading dock at KACC and demonstrated spraying technique by creating spraying-on-glass as a method of demonstrating the affect of sunlight vs. no-sunlight on the yellowing of lacquer. The idea is to show that the sprayed glass exposed to sunlight will yellow quicker than that not exposed to sunlight. L.A. said that you can compare the lacquer you are using to another by spraying a piece of glass (half usual and half unknown), then creating an identical half and half control, and exposing the one pane of glass to the sun for days, weeks, months, and keeping the control indoors in subdued light.
