Last Meeting

Craig Timmerman gave a demonstration of how to turn a square bowl. He said there are two ways to do this, the first being to take a square piece of wood and glue sides on it, turn a round bowl and knock/saw/cut off the sides, leaving a square bowl. He demonstrated the other way, to turn a square piece of wood, turning a lot of air on the outside. This way is much easier since air is easier to knock/saw/cut off of the sides when you are finished. Here are some of his examples and a shot of him at work on the demo.



As you can see, Craig is not just a square guy, but can do rectangles, stars and hollow vessels equally well. You can find his work on line at www.armadillowoodworks.com.
