January Meeting

We have some flexibility in our meeting this month. For sure we will have the **Club Challenge,** to turn the lightest bowl you can possibly turn. There is still plenty of time to complete your entry. There's some serious money to be won. Here again are the ground rules for the contest.

The Rules:

- 1) The bowl can be any shape or from any wood, but must be in one (1) piece
- 2) The bowl must be at least 5 inches wide
- 3) The bowl must be at least 1.5 inches overall height
- 4) The bowl must have at least one (1) coat of finish
- 5) The bowl can not be pierced or otherwise have voids

All entries will be weighed at the January meeting and prizes will be awarded as follows:

- \$50 First place (lowest weight)
- \$25 Second place
- \$15 Third place
- \$10 Fourth place

We hope to see a lot of really lightweight bowls in January, so give it your best shot.

We will have some business to attend to and, If we have time, Joe Johnson will do a demo on how to use the Beall Buffing System to enhance the finish on your turnings.
