Finally, she fired up the burners and showed us how to burn designs on two pieces of Box Elder.

Finally, Raúl Peña sent this information about the Beads of Courage project that we feel will be a worthy endeavor for us all in this next year:

Beads of Courage is a nationwide-wide program to provide motivation and encouragement to youngsters by recognizing significant milestones in children's' progress through the treatments necessary in their fights against illnesses like cancer, heart disease, burns, etc.

There are 7 hospitals throughout Texas and Oklahoma participating in the program and they could use the help of you, the folks coming to SWAT. These kids need a place to store their treasure-trove of beads, and that's where you come in.

Come to SWAT (Next Year) with as many of your personally turned box lidded boxes or a flat-work boxes as you can. Turned pieces should be in the area of 6" to 12" in diameter while flat-work boxes should be at least 4"x4"x6". All these donated boxes will go to the kids after a jury selects the best three.

WoodWorld, Dallas' premier hardwood dealer and a long time vendor at SWAT, will then present the artists of these three pieces with gift certificates, as follows:
